Farmington Hills.




Jerome Rochon Youth Art

Assumption Grotto, founded in 1832, is the second oldest parish in Detroit. It is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is home to the oldest Marian Shrine in Michigan. Built in the neo-Gothic style, its limestone edifice houses unpolished marble walls, an altar and communion rail hand carved from Italian marble, and 15 stained glass windows.

The Choir and members of the DSO perform orchestral Masses by classical composers. The parish hosts lectures by noted Catholic authors as well as theatrical performances.
